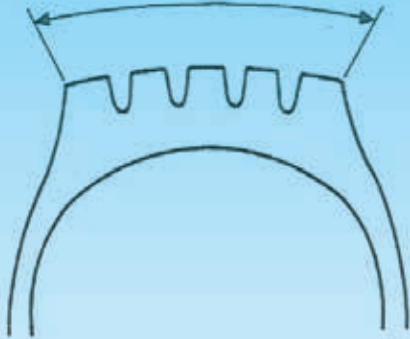


Truck Tyre Injury Guidance

Rapid Wear



AREA:

TREAD

CONDITION:

Tread wearing much faster than normally expected.

CAUSES:

- Incorrect vehicle geometry settings.
- Incorrect tyre pressure.
- Incorrect mounting of tyre on rim.
- Faulty mechanical parts such as suspension, rotating parts and brake parts.
- Tyres are not rotated timely.
- Misapplication for the conditions of use.
- Incorrect seasonal applications and incorrect evaluation of wear for different axle positions.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Adjust alignment correctly.
- Mount tyres on rims correctly.
- Repair mechanical parts such as suspension as well as rotating and brake components.
- Rotate tyres timely.

- Use the correct pattern and/or specification for the intended condition of use.
- Use the correct pattern and/or specification for the seasonal applications.

HOW TO CHECK:

Inspect the tread surface carefully to see the conditions of abrasions.
